**3. Approval of Minutes:**

**5. Superintendent/Director Report:**

Superintendent, R. Goebel reviewed the Hampton Township lead action level exceedances. T. Close shared details about the public meeting that was held at the Hampton Township Hall. A lengthy conversation followed.

R. Goebel displayed the corrosion coupon testing procedure. A corrosion coupon rack will be installed in Hampton Township and possibly at another location in the distribution system.

A five year flow chart comparison was displayed on the monitors from 2015 - 2019. Water usage has decreased for 2019.

**Plant Happenings:**

- Caustic pump skid rebuild – leak has been repaired and the maintenance department made an improvement to the system
- Membrane Pinning – sonic testing is being performed quarterly
- May Evoqua visit – membrane skids are showing a good recovery after chemical washes
- Raw Water Pump #2 – mechanical seal is leaking
- Electric Sub-Station – Consumers Energy has fallen behind on their maintenance agreement, a meeting was held and they are back on site attempting to catch up.
- PFAS – BAWTP tap and raw results were non-detect in April
- Staffing Updates – Operations Specialist Angie Johnson started operating a shift on July 2

**6. Other Matters:**

J. Lillo stated that in the near future, meetings will begin to take place regarding the State Park Drive project. This project will involve multiple parties. Currently surveys are being done within the 2 ½ - 3 mile range of State Park Drive.

M. Jurish asked about any updates on the water module being prepared by Johnson and Anderson. Per J. Lillo, the updated water module should be completed by the end of this year.

7. **Public Comment:**




8. **Adjourn:**
