- Raw water pump #2 mechanical seal has been replaced

EGLE has requested that an investigation be done in Hampton Township due to the lead action level exceedances. Hampton Township is seeking a contractor to remove their lead service lines.

Director, B. Bohlen reported that all three pumps are operating at the Nine Mile pump station.

The pre-bid mandatory meeting for the 500,000 gallon ground storage tank has taken place. Bids will be opened at the next BCRC board meeting.

Four proposals were received for the water modeling services. Johnson and Anderson, DLZ was awarded the bid.

B. Bohlen briefed the committee on the National Rural Water Association apprenticeship program. R. Goebel is currently communicating with Delta College and the US Department of Labor in regards to the possibility of setting up apprenticeships at the BAWTP and WWTP. The Water Environmental Technology program currently has few participants. B. Bohlen has been meeting with the Corporate Services Director at Delta College. Bay County DWS will be attending career day at Delta College in the fall.
