6. Superintendent Report:

Superintendent; R. Goebel displayed photos of the 10 MG raw water tank being cleaned. NTEC will be inspecting the tank later in the week. Cleaning of the tank is scheduled to be done biannually. The plan is to eventually turn the raw water tank into a finished water tank for additional water storage. The finished water tanks will be inspected within the next four weeks, this is an EGLE requirement. The tanks will be drained and disinfected before going back into service.

The Suez scope of services for water tower maintenance was displayed and reviewed. The prioritized list is based off EGLE recommendations.

New inlet piping and flex couplings have been installed on the CIP and Neutralization tanks. Photos were shown of the project being completed and a detailed description of the repairs was presented.

No PFAS was found in the WTP March 2021 tap water sample. EGLE has sampled the Saginaw-Midland raw water source and that also was a non-detect. The next WTP tap water sample will be taken in 2022.

The 2020 Consumer Confidence Report was displayed and discussed. The link is available on the Bay County DWS website and consumer notifications are being printed on the billings. There were no monitoring violations to report.

Vice-Chairman; G. Rowley inquired about the raw and finished water tanks. Superintendent; R. Goebel offered an invitation to view the inside of the raw water tank while it was open; D. Schabel and G. Augustyniak accepted.
