3. Pledge of Allegiance:

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

4. EGLE Directive:

Director; B. Bohlen informed the Committee that EGLE (Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy) issued the Bay Area Water Treatment Plant a Tier 2 Violation on September 15, 2021. The public must be notified by mail by October 15, 2021.

Superintendent; R. Goebel presented the summary of events. Between May 11, 2021 – September 1, 2021 Phosphoric Acid that was not NSF 60 Certified was fed into the Bay Area Water System. All water treatment chemicals are required to be NSF 60 Certified. Phosphoric Acid is added to water for corrosion control.

NSF 60 Certification Standard establishes minimum health effects requirements for the chemical, the contaminants and the impurities that are directly added to drinking water from drinking water treatment chemicals.

The chemical unloading policy was explained and discussed. All chemical suppliers have a copy of the BAWTP chemical specs.

Staff discovered the phosphoric acid was technical grade on August 31, 2021; EGLE was immediately notified. EGLE instructed to continue feeding the technical grade. EGLE stated that not feeding any phosphoric acid would have been worse than feeding the technical grade. NSF 60 phosphoric acid was received at the plant on September 1, 2021 and fed into the system. EGLE stated that there would be no fines due to the immediate reporting by Superintendent; R. Goebel.

The BAWTP collected a plant tap sample while feeding the tech grade phosphoric acid. It was tested for metals and results showed nothing wrong.

A sample of the uncertified phosphoric acid was delivered to NSF International in Ann Arbor on September 17, 2021. Results may show that the chemical test results are in compliance with the standard. Phosphoric acid can be both Technical Grade and NSF 60. Sample results are expected by October 1, 2021.

The tentative notice was displayed and discussed. S. Davidson suggested highlighting certain sections of the notification. G. Augustyniak asked about the chemical supplier. A lengthy conversation followed.
