The City of Pinconning has requested to expand its water supply into Standish Township, White's Beach area. Pinconning City Manager; B. Lakin updated the committee on the current water and sewer system status. The expansion would be maintained and financed by the City of Pinconning. Water lines have been in place for nearly two years. The City of Pinconning has the capability to supply water and sewer to the White's Beach area. The current sewer situation in the White's Beach area has many deficiencies. This would affect approximately 200-250 residents. A lengthy conversation took place.
