#### 4. Approval of Minutes:

<u>Vice-Chairman</u>; G. Rowley motioned to approve the January 5, 2023 minutes as presented. T. <u>Close supported the motion</u>. The motion passed unanimously.

## 6. Superintendent/Director Report:

Superintendent; R. Goebel displayed images of the new membranes being installed on skids #8 and #5. A detailed explanation of the membrane removal and replacement process was presented. The replacement membranes have all-new greased O-rings. Pressure testing was performed on a number of the membranes as they were installed to ensure that they weren't damaged. A comparison image was displayed of an old membrane and a new membrane, the old membrane had a bit of debris at the bottom end. Each membrane since the plant start-up in 2015 has filtered an estimated 10 million gallons of raw water.

A TMP (Transmembrane Pressure) graph was displayed for the month of January on skid #8. This is the measure of pressure required to push water through the filters. A permeability graph was displayed for the month of January on skid #8. This is the measurement of how easily water flows through the membranes. A permeability graph was displayed showing monthly averages from 2018 – 2022. The permeability has greatly improved with the replacement membranes.

The 2022 pipe support work is almost completed. The punch list is in the process of being finalized.

A review of the scheduled 2023 pipe support Capital Project was presented.

The Euclid finished water flow meter has arrived and will be installed internally soon.

SVSU Marketing Department has teamed up with Bay County DWS to help increase public trust and non-crisis communication. A customer survey/marketing plan is in progress. The goal is to improve positive public relations.

### S. Davidson asked about the permeability graph

Vice-Chairman; G. Rowley added the importance of each community adding a budget line item for public relations in 2024

M. Jurish suggested a positive public relations topic

#### **Director Report:**

Director; B. Bohlen will attend the MRWA Annual Conference in March and take a sample of the BAWTP tap water to enter the Water Taste Test competition.

B. Bohlen is a new member of the Water Asset Management Council (WAMC) which is a nine-member board appointed by the Michigan Infrastructure Council (MIC). A meeting will be conducted in the Bay Region to discuss the MIC's 30-year infrastructure master plan which includes water, sanitary sewer, storm sewer, and electrical utilities. Members of the TAC are encouraged to attend this session once the final date is determined in April or May.

An amendment has been made to the Bay County DWS and Saginaw Midland Water Supply Agreement to extend the City of Pinconning strictly to the Whites Beach area.

The Water Supply Agreement with Frankenlust Township, the City of Saginaw, and Bay County DWS is being reviewed.
