3. Pledge of Allegiance:

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

4. Approval of Minutes:

Vice-Chairman; G. Rowley motioned; C. Goulet supported the approval of the October 2, 2025, minutes as presented. The motion passed unanimously.

6. 2026 BAWTP Budget Approval:

Accounting & HR Manager; K. Christian explained the water rate structure. She displayed the multiple variables involved in the proposed 2026 cost of water and gave a detailed explanation.

D. Schabel motioned, B. Pawlak supported to approve the 2026 BAWTP Budget. 62.15 % Yeas, 31.31% Nays; motion was adopted on a roll call vote.

7. Superintendent Report:

Superintendent; C. Overly displayed the October water flows. The daily average was about 6.84 MGD for the month. A historical comparison of million gallons per week was shared. Water temperatures, chemical treatment dosages and the treatment process for the month were presented.

The finished water chlorine analyzer experienced a failure in October. The plant has transitioned to a Pilot Chemtrac analyzer. The device is working well.

The finished water tank #1 was taken down for cleaning, inspection and a modification. Staff did their own visual inspection and Nelson Tank was hired for a third-party opinion.

A modification was done to the west hatch of the tank to allow for sampling and draining. (EGLE Approved)

After successful testing on Floc Tank #1, the same changes were implemented on Floc Tank #2. These changes have improved floc formation and settling performance. Photos were displayed of the improved process.

EGLE recently hosted a virtual summit on Microplastics. Carl shared information and details of the all-day event.

A staffing update was presented.

G. Rowley asked a question about the treatment process

G. Augustyniak inquired about the water recycling process

Director Report:

Director, R. Goebel stated that the 2026 BAWTP budget will be presented at the next Bay County Road Commission meeting for approval.

A raw water tanks update was presented. Bids will be gathered in early spring for the steel tanks.

G. Augustyniak asked about the expected price difference for steel tanks rather than concrete

T. Close asked about the water circulation in the steel raw water tanks
