G. Augustyniak – Question on cross connection checks with Whites Beach water hook up.

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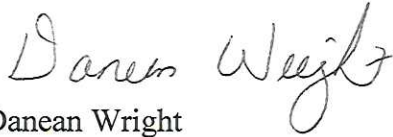
